What is Student Executive Council?

Student Executive Council is a body made up of selected SAEINDIA collegiate club office bearers to manage the student activities in Southern Section. This council has 9 members.

These members are selected using the following process:

Nominations are received from collegiate clubs.

One nomination from each club

Nominated member should not be in the final year

Student activities team of SAEINDIA Southern Section selects members based on the following criteria:

Activity level of the nominating club

Strength of the nominating club

Involvement of the nominated student in SAE activities

Academic performance of the nominated student

What are the roles of Student Executive Council?

The main purpose of the Council is to manage the student activities of SAEINDIA.

This can be looked at three levels:

Policies

Strategies and

Execution

The council is expected to participate in framing the policies of student activities with SAEINDIA and its sections and review these policies from time to time. In this area, the council would have a limited role. The council may suggest improvements and modifications but the major policy directions will be decided by SAEINDIA and its sections.

Strategies would be jointly evolved by the council and SAEINDIA. In this area the council would have a stronger influence.

Council would have a near autonomous role in execution while the support would be coming from SAEINDIA.

What are the current policies of SAEINDIA for student activities?

The vision of SAEINDIA is life long learning. Hence students are also involved in its vision. Students undergo learning through academic curriculum. The policy of SAEINDIA is to provide additional learning to make the students ready for real life, in the mobility area.

This learning has to be in two aspects as given below:

Ability to relate the knowledge gained in academic curriculum to the real world

Ability to acquire additional knowledge as required

What are the current strategies of SAEINDIA for student activities?

Program contents:

The programs would have fun and learning elements. They will also be aligned with the academic curriculum without much deviation.

Partnership:

All the programs will be conducted in partnership with industry and academic institutions.

Improving participation:

The strategy has three elements, namely, "Engage, Enthuse and Enroll"

"Engage" element:

Conduct interesting programs in colleges having active SAEINDIA Collegiate clubs so that all the members are engaged

"Enthuse" element:

Communicate the activities of active clubs to the SAEINDIA Collegiate clubs that are dormant so that they are enthused and start conducting some programs

"Enroll" element:

Encourage and help other colleges to start SAEINDIA Collegiate clubs

What are the current programs of SAEINDIA for students?

To improve the ability to relate academic learning to the real world

Factory visit

SAE Trek

Lecture by practicing engineers

Career Guidance (earlier called as mentoring)

To inculcate the culture of acquiring additional knowledge by seeking

Student competitions

Quiz

Technical paper

Design

Development and testing – baja, aero etc

How would the Council function?

The council will have a chairman, secretary and treasurer elected within the council.

The council will meet at regular intervals to discuss the matters related to student activities. Management Committee Members of SAEINDIA responsible for student activities will participate in these meetings.

The meetings will focus on

- Planning and execution of various student programs
- Identifying new initiatives and making its proposals to SAEINDIA
- Evolving strategies to improve and spread the student activities

The council can form additional sub-committees to handle specific activities and initiatives. Club officers outside the executive council will be drafted in as sub-committee members as needed. The suggested sub-committees, their roles and activities are given in Annex-1

How will to the operating expenses be managed?

Executive committee meeting expenses will be borne by SAEINDIA. However, the council will be expected to be prudent in their expenses.

In case, the council member has to travel for the purpose of the meeting or any assigned job, second class train fare will be reimbursed by SAEINDIA.

How will the fund required for programs be managed?

Funding of all programs will be organised by SAEINDIA. However, the council may have to play a significant role in marketing the programs and drafting in sponsors.

The executive council will be authorized to spend according to the approved budget. The council will have to provide proper account of the expenses with supporting vouchers.
